VOLUNTEER AND OUTREACH BUILDING INTERIOR

\$30,000

Our Volunteer and Outreach building was built in 2017 with monies from various grants. Our wish list for this building is to install heating and air conditioning, insulation, drywall, interior kennels, a projector, and a pull-down projector screen. Eventually, we would like to have children's birthday parties, training classes, and community events in this building. We would like to offer your business inside building signage if you selected this as your project. This building has been vital over the past year to quarantine pets arriving from abuse and neglect situations. It offers volunteers the opportunity to work with rescue animals along with providing additional educational and training programs.

MEDICAL VETERINARY PLATFORM SCALE

\$475

The scale is used prior to surgeries to weigh animals and to determine the correct dose of medicine they need. The cost for a Pet Veterinary Platform Scale with 700-pound capacity is approximately \$475.

MEDICAL MICROSCOPE

\$500 - \$900

CBHS medical department is in need of a microscope. It will be used to identify life-threatening blood disorders, parasite identification, fecal analysis, diagnose of skin infections, and much more. This will help reduce the cost of sending samples to an outside laboratory. Procedures could then be done in-house with less cost and faster results.

PEA GRAVEL FOR OUTDOOR PLAY AREAS *COMPLETED*

\$3,700

We need 92 tons of pea gravel to cover our outdoor dog play areas. This would allow for a 2-inch depth. Pea gravel is easy to maintain. All dogs spend time in outdoor pens daily. Pea gravel keeps pens manageable and pets clean during our outdoor play times. Donations of pea gravel, financial support of this project, and volunteer help in placing the gravel would be greatly appreciated.

COMMERCIAL DISHWASHER, COUNTERTOP AND SINK

\$12,000

CBHS needs one large double deep sink, and a commercial automatic dishwasher to sanitize and wash the animal's dishes. The kennel staff currently hand wash over 90 food and water dishes and litter boxes every morning. This will result in time savings and sanitary pet bowls, reducing the spread of illness.

CAT CONDOS FOR ADOPTION CENTER LOBBY

\$20,000

We currently have ten cats housed in individual lobby kennels, separated from the two large cat colony rooms. We frequently need special housing for the cats that have dietary needs or do not cohabitate well in the cat rooms. Cat condos are stainless steel, include a shelf and a pass through to a side litter box area allowing pets private and sanitary accommodations.

ADOPTION CENTER OUTDOOR SIGNAGE

\$1,300

Signage would be beneficial in directing CBHS visitors to the appropriate building on campus. This is the estimated cost for one 40 inches by 80 inches, one-sided, PVC post sign.

DENTAL TABLE AND INTRAVENOUS POLES

\$3,500

Numerous pets arrive with dental disease that require treatment. We have the necessary dental equipment but we lack a dental table that allows us to lift, move, and examine patients safely and more easily. IV poles are used often during surgery and to administer fluids and medication to sick and injured pets. We lack IV poles to provide a secure place to hang bags of medicine or fluid while performing surgeries on these pets.
